## New and Enhanced Features

The releases include the following new features and enhancements:

### People Bulk File Download

The set of entity bulk files available for download from PermID.org (or via the Bulk Download API) now includes a file for the Person entity. You can use this file to create an initial Person entity repository, and then use the Person Atom Feed to retrieve incremental updates to Person entities.

The bulk file for the Person entity type also contains all auxiliary objects needed to create the person entity graph, such as EducationMetadata and PositionMetadata and education and professional relationships.

**Note:** The bulk file for the Person entity type also contains all auxiliary objects needed to create the entity graph, such as Education and Position related objects. Due to potential data issues, the entity graph might contain links to unavailable records. The amount of such broken links is minor. We are doing our best to address it in future releases.

**Note:** The PermID is a permanent identifier, and as such, once created a PermID can never be deleted. These defunct records are present in the PermID.org data and the bulk files, with Publication Status other than 'Published'. These records are included for continuity only and are not actively maintained. Therefore, some of the information they contain may be outdated or incorrect.

## Known Issues

An error message might appear when matching request is sent via UI for large input files ( $\geq 500$  records). The Record Matching API works well on big files (up to 1000 records).
